

Curvalicious Table Runner Class Supply List

Thank you for taking the Curvalicious Table Runner Class. This is a fun, easy project and we should be able to get to the actual quilting of the table runner with our decorative stitches so be prepared to have your batting and backing fabric with you.

- Curvalicious Ruler with Table Runner Pattern
- If you have sandpaper dots or a double sided tape to put on the backside of your ruler to prevent slipping please bring with you.
- 24" ruler to cut strips
- 28mm Rotary Cutter - this size cutter is needed to cut out the curves safely and accurately.
- 1 ¼ yards of Paper Backed Fusible such as Heat N Bond Lite or Featherlite
- 6 Different Colored Quarter Yards measuring 9" x 44". -This is for the front strips, curves and dots
- ½ yard of Backing Fabric
- 18"x 45" piece of batting
- Thread for piecing strips together.
- Threads for Decorative Stitches for Quilting- I used a variegated thread.
- Your machine with ¼ inch foot and a clear Applique Foot.
- Basic Sewing Notions - curved basting Pins for sandwiching the quilt top
- Iron and pressing surface so you don't have to wait in line to use the guild irons.
- Frixion Pen or chalk pencil for tracing circles
- Scissors for cutting out paper backed fusible fabric circles.
